



The University of Applied Sciences in Osnabrück and Osnabrück City Council are awarding a scholarship to one person from each of Osnabrück's twin cities and friendship cities - namely Angers (France), Çanakkale (Turkey), Derby (UK), Haarlem (Netherlands), Twer (Russia), Hefei (China), Evansville (USA) and Vila Real (Portugal). The scholarship will enable this person to attend the 30th International Summer Language School run by the University of Applied Sciences in Osnabrück.

The 30th International Summer Language School will take place between the 23th of August to the 20th of September 2022 and comprises 90 hours of intensive German language training, offered at all levels.

The language course will be accompanied by a wide programme of events. In the afternoons and at weekends there will be presentations, tours of companies, sports and social events, as well as excursions on offer. At the end of the course there will be a four-day trip to Berlin and Potsdam. The course is aimed at students or those in employment, with or without previous knowledge of the German language (from beginners to advanced). The scholarship will cover the course fees as well as the costs for accommodation and health insurance. There is one scholarship available to each of the aforementioned twin cities of Osnabrück. A basic command of the German language is not a prerequisite for the scholarship. Applicants must be aged 18 or over.

- 5. Any other documentation which may support your application

Selection criteria

- Convincing display of interest in learning German, with reasons as to why it would be of use to you
- Relationship to Derby (studies, work etc.)

Information regarding COVID-19

Provided that the Corona situation allows the courses to be held in a face-to-face setting, the Summer Language School 2022 will take place on-site and in compliance with the appropriate safety precautions regarding, for example, proof of vaccination, of recovery or of a test.

Lectures at the Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences are currently (March 2022) held on-site according to the 3G rule. (3G in German stands for "Geimpft - genesen - getestet" translating to "vaccinated or recovered or tested").

If the pandemic situation is similar in August 2022, participants who fulfill the 3G requirements can participate in the program.

However, according to the Federal Ministry of the Interior and Community, people from countries that do not belong to the European Union can only enter Germany if they are fully vaccinated (with a vaccine that is officially recognized in Germany https://www.pei.de/DE/newsroom/dossier/coronavirus/coronavirus-
